Individuals stand out in top Environment awards

Outstanding work by individuals feature in Australia's "environmental Oscars" announced tonight.

Innovative programs to preserve the natural habitat, limit food waste, build bridges between architecture and the environment and encourage young individuals to take charge of their surroundings were rewarded in the annual United Nations Association of Australia World Environment Day Awards.

Daniel Brindley has given time, money and knowledge to help the Australian bush and its wildlife, by reshaping parts of the Mornington Peninsula and other areas in Victoria. He set up the Habitat Restoration Fund and works with people from broken families, a background of drug or alcohol abuse, the intellectually disabled and disengaged youth. He wins the individual award.

Working alone, SBS World News correspondent Stefan Armbruster reached remote parts of the Solomon Islands to reveal how rising sea levels are forcing people off their land. His report, *Dying Islands*, was shown on SBS World News, as well as on radio and online. Armbruster's confronting reports are used in universities and by Pacific Islands newspapers. He wins the media award.

The remarkable range covered by the awards is shown by prizes going to a leader in sustainability in the Daintree, Queensland, a study of dolphins at Kangaroo Island in South Australia, work with wildlife by Melbourne's Boroondara Council and a revolutionary building at 171 Collins St, Melbourne.

The Seeley International gas heating range was also applauded, with a prize going to a new design that cuts energy use and the impact on the environment. (See below for complete list of winners).
