The Hotspot Heroes Enviro-Stories Program involves schools from the Wheatbelt region of Western Australia learning about the biodiversity, threatened species and feral animals in the wheatbelt area.

Students have the opportunity to be a Hotspot Hero and become published authors by writing and illustrating a biodiversity-themed short story, focusing on local threatened species and communities. They will explore and discover these environmental hotspots by learning about their value, habitats, threats and how to protect them for future generations. Stories that are published will become resources to teach others about our precious area.
