
















Gemma replied with, "You just wait, you'll pay for talking like that to us". Then they all swam off with a swish of their huge tails.

Why couldn't she stand up for herself like her friends had?







With a new found swish in her swim


Penny arrived at school ready to play




Shocked and very scared that he could hear her, Penny tried to swim away, but was trapped by the plastic bucket.
