"Is there anything I can do?" she asked.








"I'll think of a way to get him back. I promise you that I will bring him home in perfect condition," explained Pip.

"Don't worry," whispered Pip, "I am here to get you out. I will take you home."


"But you're only a little bird, how will you save me?" whimpered the joey.
