




I love our Lakes because the sound of the cool calm water lapping at the sand is really relaxing.

I love how the water is so clear you can see the pretty shells and sometimes little animals swimming around.


I love how every day is different - sometimes the water is very still and other times it is rough and has waves.







I love our Lakes because of the glorious and colourful wildlife living here.

I love the sounds and smells of the animals and plants in the bush.










I love our Lakes because we can go camping in the summer and spend the whole day playing water sports.

I love pushing it to the limit and sometimes falling off, racing with my friends and riding through the water spraying mud everywhere.




I love our Lakes because I like walking through the Eagle Point Nature Reserve.

I love watching how the water ripples when it bounces.






I love our Lakes because of the rumble of the waves and the gentle touch of the water on your feet.
